CONFIRMATION

Upon receipt of the camper's application and deposit, a confirmation packet will be mailed to you. Your confirmation will provide you with complete information regarding all details of the camp.

LOCATION

UW-Stevens Point is located in the heart of Wisconsin, accounting for many outstanding campers that attend from all regions of the state. UWSP is 70 miles from the Fox Valley, 90 miles from Madison and Green Bay, 110 miles from La Crosse and Eau Claire, and 150 miles from Milwaukee.

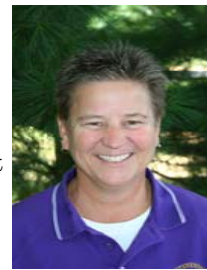
FACILITIES

As a camper at UW-Stevens Point, you will have the use of Berg Gym, home of the women's basketball team, and Quandt Fieldhouse, home of the men's team, all housed under one roof. This means no transporting campers from one site to another and no outdoor sessions.

CAMP FEATURES

All campers will receive a basketball reversible jersey, offensive and defensive skill instruction, individual instruction and evaluation. Each camper will have an opportunity to compete in league play, tournament play and in 3 on 3 games.

Shirley Egner is the winningest coach in UW-Stevens Point history with a 330-163 career record in her 18th season. Egner won her 200th career game in the 2002 NCAA Division III championship game when the Pointers defeated St. Lawrence 67-65. Her 250th win came against Hardin-Simmons (Texas), leading the Pointers to their second final four in three seasons during the 2004 campaign, and win number 300 came this past season vs. Superior. She has also led the Pointers to a 20+ win record in the last 7 of 8 seasons. Coach Egner is in her second year as chair of the NCAA Division III women's basketball tournament selection committee. She also serves as the chair for the Central Region advisory committee.

Megan Wilson completed her third year as the Pointers' assistant coach. Coach Wilson attended UW-Stevens Point and was a member of the women's basketball team from 1999-2003. During her time at UW-Stevens Point, she was winner of the Pointer Award in 2001, 2002, and 2003. Coach Wilson worked numerous camps the past two summers including UW-Green Bay and Duke University.

INSURANCE

HOUSING

Resident campers will be housed two to a room in a residence hall on the campus of UWSP. Campers receive constant supervision as counselors and coaches reside on the same floors.

Commuters are campers who elect not to stay in the residence hall. Commuters do not eat breakfast on campus but will be provided with lunch and dinner.

MEALS

All meals will be provided from off campus restaurants. The campers' fee will cover the cost of these meals. Each camper will be responsible for her meal before the first session of camp on June 18.
