I acknowledge and agree to accept and assume any and all of the risk attendant to this activity. My child's participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate notwithstanding the risks.

I hereby volunteer release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless UWSP from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my child's participation in this activity or my use of UWSP equipment or facilities whether "on" or "off" the ice, including any claims which allege negligent acts or omissions on the part of UWSP.

On-ice will consist of improving skating technique (both age groups on the ice together), stick handling, passing and shooting. We will not discuss or teach any systems. Off-ice training will include plyometrics, sprints, and skating-specific drills. We will also incorporate off-ice shooting tarps and stick handling circuits.
