Shelly also finished 8th in the NCAA for blocks per game, which helped to place the Pointers first in the WIAC for team blocks per game. Senior setter Jill Wittmann also broke into the school record books finish 3rd in most set assists in her career. Facilities

At UW Stevens Point we feel we have the finest camp facilities in the Midwest. We have access to two gymnasiums, both housed under one roof. This means no transporting campers from one site to another, no long walks across campus, no outdoor sessions and more time for instruction and skill development. Quandt Fieldhouse, Berg Gym and the Multi-Activities Center, UWSP's multi-purpose facility, also containing a swimming pool will all be utilized during the camp sessions.

Location

UWSP is located in the heart of Wisconsin, accounting for many outstanding campers that attend from all regions of the Midwest. Located along the scenic Wisconsin River, U.S. HWY 51/I-39 provides easy four lane access to the city of Stevens Point. UWSP is 70 miles from the Fox Valley, 90 miles from Green Bay/Madison, 110 miles from Eau Claire/La Crosse and 150 miles from Milwaukee.

Room/Board

Resident campers will be housed two to a room in a modern and convenient residence hall on the UWSP campus, half a block from the athletic facilities. Campers receive constant supervision as counselors and coaches room on the same floors. Meals will be served in the residence dining center which is also within walking distance of the residence halls and gyms. Some meals will be arranged at off-campus restaurants.

Refund/Deposit

A \$100 deposit must accompany all applications for overnight camps. Cancellations made prior to may 31st will be refunded the deposited amount less a \$50 administrative fee. After June 1st, refunds (less a \$50 administrative fee) will be made for special circumstance only. Each player must submit payment individually; **one group payment WILL NOT be accepted** except for tournament registration. Checks can be made payable to UW-Stevens Point Volleyball.

Commuters

Commuters are campers who elect not to stay in the residence hall. Commuters do not eat breakfast on campus but will be provided lunch and dinner. Parking Permits are available through parking services at your request. You can reach parking services at 715-346-3900.

Health History

It is required that all campers complete and have on file a UWSP Camp Health History Form. The health history form will be sent to you with your confirmation letter. Return the form to us as soon as possible. If we do not have the form on file, we cannot permit the camper to participate in the volleyball camp. Also in the confirmation letter there will be further information regarding all details of the camp.

Insurance

Campers must have health insurance or admission will be denied.

Skills/Team Camp—July 8-10th

Skill development emphasized through three days of team competition. Camp is open to all girls grades 7-12 and you can register as a team or an individual whom we will put on a team. This camp is designed to meet the needs for both individual development and team play. Campers will be learning various offensive/defensive skills and systems as well as serve receive formation and plays. Junior and Senior High campers will be split into two different gyms and tournaments.
