## Hitting Camps

Grades 3-6: Jan 18 & 25  
Grades 7-12: Feb 1, 8, 15, 22

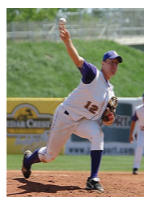
One of our best-attended camps, the Hitting Camp is a great way for ballplayers to hone their swing during the winter months. With two sessions for the young hitter and four sessions for the teenage ballplayer, there is ample opportunity for retention of information and long-term skill improvement. We introduce drills and learning cues that will facilitate understanding of the most important aspects of rotational hitting (stance, load, stride, swing path, extension). Campers will also be instructed about things such as plate discipline, swing planes, contact points, 2-strike hitting approach, and hitting the off-speed pitch. Camper to coach ratio is 4:1. You must provide your own bat for camp. Individual evaluations will be provided.



## Pitcher/Catcher Camps

Gr 3-6: Jan 18 & 25  
Gr 7-12: Mar 1 & 8

Campers looking to improve their pitching/throwing mechanics, strengthen their arms, and improve their defensive skill set should consider attending our Pitcher/Catcher Camp. Both pitchers and catchers will be able to improve their knowledge at each skill position and will benefit from the participation of one another at camp.



Emphasis will be placed on developing repeatable throwing mechanics through a series of drills and simulated bullpen sessions. Pitchers will receive specific instruction on the five-step motion sequence as well as pitch grips, pitch sequencing, and holding runners. Catchers will receive instruction on framing, blocking, bag throws, and pitch sequencing as well. Individual evaluations will be provided for each camper.

### REGISTRATION POLICIES & PROCEDURES (please read)

You must pre-register your son at least 1 week prior to the start of camp to guarantee him a spot. All registrations require a non-refundable deposit of 50% of the camp fee to hold a spot for the camper. The remaining 50% of the fee is due the first day of camp—full payment is accepted at any time. Cancellation notices received prior to the start of camp will receive a full refund (minus 50% of the camp fee) if full payment was made. Cancellations during camp will receive a prorated refund. No refunds will be given for no-shows. We thank you for your cooperation.

## Hitting & Pitching/Catching Academy

Hitting: September-October  
Pitching/Catching: November-December

For the player who is looking for baseball instruction throughout the offseason, we offer our Academies as a means to continue improving in the game when many others have put their bats and gloves away. Each Academy will last for six weeks with one 2-hour session per week. This two-hour block provides ample time to teach the critical aspects of hitting, pitching, & catching—with six opportunities for our staff to assess and evaluate your progress.

## Five-Tool Camps

Fall: September 20  
Winter: December 27-28

For the ballplayer looking to improve in all aspects of the game, we recommend our Five-Tool Camp. Focus is provided on each of the 'Five Tools' that we feel are most important in the game of baseball: 1) throwing/pitching, 2) hitting/bunting, 3) fielding (groundballs/fly balls), 4) baserunning, and 5) mental/physical training. Offered in the winter for Grades 3-6 and in the fall and winter for Grades 7-12, the Five-Tool Camps are a great way to improve your fundamental skill set and make important adjustments to your all-around game.

- 1) Fill out the attached registration form, remove it from the brochure, and mail it (along with the camp deposit/fee) to the address listed on the back of the brochure.
- 2) Upon receipt of your registration, we will send back a confirmatory e-mail which will include necessary medical & insurance information—we must have this in hand for your son to attend.
