Game Outlook: Today's first round NCAA Division III Playoff game features the 8-2 Knights of Wartburg College and the 9-1 Pointers of UW-Stevens Point. The Knights enter the game as the IIAC champions thanks to an overtime victory over the University of Dubuque last Saturday, and are currently on a five-game winning streak. The Pointers, who are ranked No. 9 in the latest D3football.com poll, come into the game as the co-champions of the WIAC along with No. 4 UW-Whitewater. The Knights will be making their seventh trip to the NCAA playoffs since 1993, while the Pointers are making their first appearance since 2001.

Series History: Today's meeting will mark the first matchup in the history of these two programs.

Radio: The game can be heard live throughout Central Wisconsin on WKQH (104.9 FM) and WWSP (89.9 FM) radio. Tom Weaver will call the play-by-play and Ken Kulick providing the analysis on WKQH while UWSP students will have the call on WWSP. Fans can listen live on the internet by visiting www.b1049.com or www.uwsp.edu/STUORG/WWSP/ and clicking the "Listen Live" button.

Last Time Out: The Pointers sealed up a share of the WIAC title with a 21-7 victory over UW-La Crosse. Jared Beckwith threw a touchdown in each of the first three quarters to Brad Kalsow to lead the way offensively. The Pointer defense stepped-up big once again, holding the Eagles to just 120 yards of offense and forced three turnovers in the victory. The win gave the Pointers their first conference championship since 2001, and gave them an automatic berth to the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

TALKIN' ABOUT PLAYOFFS!?!: Today's matchup against the Knights will mark the seventh playoff game in Pointer football history. The only time the Pointers won a playoff game was in their last postseason appearance in 2001, when they defeated Bethel University 37-27 before being bounced out in the second round by St. John's University 9-7.

GOOD KNIGHT: Wartburg is no stranger to the postseason. The 11-time Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference champions have won at least seven games in 16 consecutive seasons, and are making their seventh trip to the NCAA playoffs since 1993.

AND THE AWARD GOES TO: The Pointers were given a bevy of postseason awards for their successful WIAC run. Fourteen players were named to the All-WIAC team, including eight first-team recipients. Defensive Tackle Brad Vickroy was named the WIAC Player of the Year, while Head Coach John Miech took home Coach of the Year honors.

WE'VE GOT DEFENSE, YES WE DO: The Pointers boast the best overall defense and rushing defense in the WIAC. The Pointers are ranked 11th in the nation in rushing defense, giving up just 74 ypg, and 12th in total defense, allowing only 252.3 ypg.

POINTING THEM BACK: The stout Pointers defensive line has done a tremendous job against opposing offenses, as they are tops in the WIAC in sacks with 27 and tackles for loss with 80.

TWO TO TANGO: Brad Kalsow and Jared Jenkins continue to tear apart opposing secondaries. Jenkins and Kalsow, who were both named first-team All-WIAC performers, are both ranked in the top 20 in the nation in receptions per game. Kalsow has 74 receptions for 865 yards and six touchdowns this season, while Jenkins has amassed 72 catches for 835 yards and eight touchdowns.

THEY GOT OUR BALL - WE WANT IT BACK: The Pointers defense has forced 22 fumbles, recovering 11 of them, and also record 18 interceptions this season. The Pointers are +11 in the turnover column, and their +1.1 turnover margin per game is the best in the WIAC.

BATTLING FOR POSITION: Today's game features two of the nation's elite punters. Wartburg's Stevan Kingery is 14th in the nation with a 40.38 punting average and UW-Stevens Point's Luke Frisch is 27th in the nation with a 39.45 average.

Pointers Hold Off Webber For Spud Bowl Victory

STEVENS POINT – Webber International outgained the Pointers 253 to 177 on Saturday afternoon, but a solid defensive effort in the game's final minutes allowed the Pointers to hold off the Warriors, opening the 2008 season with a 23-21 win.

The UWSP defense came out strong in the game's opening drive, forcing a 3 play negative 11 yard drive that resulted in a Warrior punt. The Pointers then posted a seven play, 30 yard drive, highlighted by a Jared Beckwith (Baraboo) pass completion to Aaron Leonhardt (Baraboo) that put UWSP in range of Ryan Graboski (Woodbury, Minn.), who put the Pointers up 3-0 on a 33-yard field goal.

Grabowski added another field goal, this time from 36 yards out, after UWSP's Brian Bailey (New Lisbon) recovered a Webber fumble forced by Brad Vickroy (Wis. Rapids/Lincoln), putting the Pointers on top 6-0.

In the second half, Webber pieced together a 10 play, 97 yard drive to take a 7-6 lead with 2:20 left in the third quarter, their only lead of the game. On the play, Webber quarterback Daniel Lafleur (Stuart, Fla.) found Taylor Atwood (Davie, Fla.) for a 39-yard completion down the left sideline to paydirt.

The Pointers answered back an eight play, 31 yard drive that put Grabowski in range for a 26 yard field goal as UWSP regained the lead, one they did not relinquish.

The Pointers added seven more points just two plays later as Stremkowski recovered a Lafleur fumble and T.C. Farber picked up 22 of his 42 yards on the day on the Pointers first play, going around the right side and finding the end zone for a quick six points.

Webber again capitalized on a UWSP turnover two drives later, as Lafleur found Sergio Rivera for a 19 yard touchdown with 3:03 remaining, cutting the lead to just two, 23-21. This time, the two-point conversion was good, cutting UWSP's lead to 23-21.

After a three-and-out by the Pointers, the defense again stepped up, as Bryan Blum (Baraboo) intercepted Lafleur, sealing the victory for the Pointers.

For the Pointers, Beckwith finished the day going 18-for-30 for 154 yards and no touchdowns. Farber had 15 carries for 42 yards and one touchdown. Graboski was 3-for-4 on field goals, connecting from 33, 36 and 26 yards out. Brad Kalsow (Huntley, Ill.) was the Pointers leading receiver on the day, snagging seven balls for 77 yards.

On defense, Tyler Florczak (Chetek) led the day for the Pointer defense, registering 11 tackles, four solo. Stremkowski added 10 and Charlie Dercks (Little Chute) had nine, including two tackles for a loss of seven yards.

Pointers Roll Iowa Wesleyan 45-7

STEVENS POINT – The UW-Stevens Point football team wasted no time in shaking off last week's slow offensive start on Saturday, as they racked up 329 yards of total offense, defeating Iowa Wesleyan 45-7 in a rain-soaked affair at Community Stadium at Goerke Park.

The Pointers got on the board early, taking the opening kickoff and driving down the field in a six play, 62 yard scoring drive that culminated in Jared Beckwith (Baraboo) finding Brad Kalsow (Huntley, Ill.) for a 10 yard touchdown strike. Ryan Graboski's (Woodbury, Minn.) kick made the game 7-0 just over two minutes into the contest.

Just two plays into Iowa Wesleyan's first drive, the Tigers coughed up the ball and UWSP's Charlie Dercks (Little Chute) pounced on the ball, giving the Pointers the ball back inside the visitor's 20. Just five plays later, C.L. Whiteside (Milwaukee) got the call and punched the ball across the goal line, giving the Pointers a 13-0 advantage with 10:38 remaining in the opening quarter. Graboski's kick made the score 14-0.

From there, the Iowa Wesleyan defense forced two three-and-out possessions by the Pointers until another fumble by the Tigers gave the Pointers the ball deep in Iowa Wesleyan territory. The Pointers drove to the visitor's four yard line, but the Tiger defense kept UWSP out of the end zone, forcing a 21 yard Grabowski field goal attempt. The kick floated wide right, and the Pointers were unable to convert on the Tiger fumble.

In the second half, it was again all Pointer offense, as Graboski added a 41-yard field goal on the Pointer's first possession of the second half after forcing another three-and-out by the Tiger offense, 38-0. The lone Pointer turnover of the day came at the end of the third quarter, as a Beckwith pass was intercepted by Gerald Knighten (Bellwood, Ill.) and returned 13 yards to the Pointer 25. Greg Fields (St. Louis, Mo.) put the Tigers on the board at the start of the fourth quarter, breaking away for a 19 yard touchdown run and a Scott Knipfer (Cottage Grove, Wis.) made the score 38-7.

Point answered with a score of their own, stringing together a nine play 68 yard touchdown drive that ended with Beckwith finding Jake Swank (Oregon) on a four-yard touchdown pass, putting the Pointers on top 45-7.

The Pointer defense owned the show from there, holding the Tigers to 14 total yards in the game's final 10:29 as UWSP went on to the 38-point victory.

After a Jack Marx (Scandinavia) 23 yard kick return put the Pointers in Azusa territory, Beckwith found Kalsow for completions of three, two and 17 yards to give the Pointers a first and 10 on the Azusa 14 yard line when Beckwith found Kalsow for the tying score. Graboski's kick was good, and the Pointers went ahead 10-9.

With :53 remaining and Azusa driving, Tyler Florczak (Chetek) sealed the game with an interception, his second of the game, to give the Pointers the ball, and the win, 10-9.

Offensive Explosion not enough as Falcons down Pointers 36-30

RIVER FALLS - UW-Stevens Point had their best day through the air so far this season, passing for 234 yards and two touchdowns, but the Pointer offense managed just 70 yards on the ground and the defense allowed 610 all-purpose yards as the Falcons of UW-River Falls handed the Pointers their first loss of the season, 36-30, in the WIAC opener for both teams.

Down 6-0 after a Falcon touchdown and failed extra point, Ryan Graboski (Woodbury, Minn.) capped a nine play, 34 yard drive for the Pointers with a 24 yard field goal, putting the Pointers on the board 6-3.

Jared Jenkins (Milwaukee) tallied six catches for 51 yards while Brad Kalsow (Huntley, Ill.) recorded five catches for 56 yards. Mike Ferron (Racine) finished as the leading rusher for the Pointers, gaining 58 yards on 12 carries, including a long of 28, for a 4.8 per carry average.

This was the second time in eight days a UW-Stevens Point team coached by a member of the Miech family has shutout Platteville, as the women's soccer team collected a 6-0 victory over the Pioneers on Oct. 4.

Pointer Defense Spoils UW-Stout's Homecoming

MENOMONIE - The UW-Stevens Point defense held UW-Stout to just 26 yards rushing and added a safety as the Pointers defeated the Blue Devils 19-9 in Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference action Saturday at Williams Stadium in Menomonie.

In a game which saw both teams combine for 27 penalties totaling 254 yards, the Pointer defense shined through and the offense provided enough big plays to give UWSP its fifth consecutive win over UW-Stout.

Pointers Upset No. 2 UW-Whitewater

WHITEWATER - Jared Jenkins (Milwaukee) hauled in a 10-yard pass from Jared Beckwith (Baraboo) and then caught the two-point conversion attempt, again from Beckwith, with :15 remaining as the Pointers upset No. 2 ranked UW-Whitewater on Homecoming in Perkins Stadium, 17-16.

The win by the Pointers snaps a 25-game conference winning streak and a 29-game home winning streak for Whitewater, dating back to Nov. 13, 2004.

Whitewater scored first, off a 33-yard touchdown reception by Aaron Rusch but UWSP senior Bryan Blum (Baraboo) got a hand on the extra point, keeping the Warhawk advantage to 6-0 with 13:02 left in the opening quarter.

Stevens Point answered when Ryan Graboski (Woodbury, MN) capped a 10 play, 56-yard drive with a 20-yard field goal, getting the Pointers on the board and cutting the deficit to three, 6-3.

The third quarter was a defensive struggle, as neither team could muster up any offense. Whitewater threatened when they drove down to the Pointer 30-yard, but came away empty-handed when Jeff Schebler's field goal sailed wide left.

On the ensuing possession, the Warhawks took advantage of three Stevens Point penalties setting up a first-and-goal at the Pointer 7-yard line. The Pointer defense held tight, forcing Whitewater to settle for a field goal which gave the Warhawks a 16-9 lead with just 4:49 remaining in the game.

Point got the ball back at their own 16-yard line needing to score a touchdown with just 1:33 remaining on the clock. That's when things got exciting at Perkins Stadium.

After an incompletion, Beckwith hit Jenkins on a 12-yard pass. Then after a couple of incompletions and a Whitewater offside penalty, Beckwith hit Jenkins again on a 19-yard pass for another Point first down.

On the next series, Beckwith scrambled for ten yards to give the Pointers a first down at the UWW 38. Beckwith then went back to the well, hitting Jenkins for two 14-yard completions to give the Pointers a first-and-goal at the UWW 10-yard line with :20 remaining.

The Pointers capped off a 15 play, 79 yard drive against one of the nation's top defenses when Beckwith found Jenkins again on a 10-yard pass for a Pointer touchdown to make the score 16-15.

The Pointers decided to go for the win by attempting a two-point conversion. After a couple of timeouts, Beckwith once again found Jenkins for the conversion to give the Pointers a 17-16 lead with just :15 showing on the clock.

Pointers Win Thriller Over Oshkosh 34-33

STEVENS POINT - After an emotional win over the defending national champion UW-Whitewater Warhawks, the Pointers came out ahead in another exciting finish as they defeated the Titans of UW-Oshkosh 34-33 in overtime at Community Stadium in Stevens Point Saturday afternoon.

After a couple of special teams let downs, the Pointers trailed by 14 points late in the fourth quarter when Jared Beckwith (Baraboo) scored on a quarterback sneak to cut the deficit to seven with 5:02 remaining in the fourth quarter.

The Pointers defense forced the Titans to punt on the ensuing possession, which gave the Pointers the ball back at their own 27 yard-line. The Pointers marched down the field and scored a touchdown on a pass from Beckwith to Jack Marx (Scandinavia) with just :34 remaining in regulation. Ryan Graboski (Woodbury, MN) hit the extra point to tie the score and send the game into overtime.

In the overtime frame, the Pointers struck first when Mike Ferron (Racine) plowed into the endzone on a 7-yard run to give the Pointers the lead. But the Titans came right back with a touchdown of their own on a 14-yard pass to Charlie Weissman from Craig McClelland.

Faced with a similar situation the Pointers found themselves in a week ago, Titans head coach Pat Cerroni opted to go for the two-point conversion and the win. The Pointers sealed up the victory when McClelland's fade pass to Steve Levonowich was broken up by Kody Morgan (Scandinavia) in the corner of the endzone.

The rest of the Pointers scoring came from a 61-yard pass from Beckwith to Jared Jenkins (Milwaukee) on the opening drive and a pair of field goals from Graboski.

The Titans received much of their scoring from their special teams. Matt Haass threw a touchdown pass to Weissman on a fake field goal attempt and Jeremy Roach ran back the opening kickoff of the second half 90 yards for a touchdown. Haass and Roach also caught touchdowns from 14 and 71 yards respectively.

Beckwith had a career day passing for the Pointers, finishing 32 of 59 with 470 yards two touchdowns and two interceptions. Brad Kalsow (Huntley, IL) and Jenkins caught a majority of Beckwith's passes. Kalsow had 12 catches for 134 yards and Jenkins grabbed 10 passes for 204 yards and a touchdown.

After a scoreless first quarter, the Blugolds scored the only points of the first half off a 29-yard pass from Kyle Paulson found Cory Sartorelli to give UWEC the early 7-0 advantage.

In the second half, it was again Sartorelli, who this time scored on a 43-yard run to give the Blugolds a 14-0 edge with 12:12 to go in the third quarter.

The Pointers scored their first points of the day with 4:10 left in the third when Jenkins hauled in a 15-yard pass from Beckwith to make the score 14-7 Eau Claire. At the start of the fourth, it was again Jenkins, this time on a 7-yard reception from Beckwith to tie the score at 14-14 with 14:19 remaining in the game.

After the Blugold scored with :28 left but failed at the extra point try to take a 20-14 lead, UW-Stevens Point's Jack Marx (Scandinavia) took the ensuing kickoff 23 yards to the 39 yard line and a 15-yard face mask penalty gave the Pointers the ball on the Eau Claire half of the field at the 46-yard line with :24 remaining in the game. Beckwith then hit Jenkins for an 18-yard first down and then again on the 28-yard score to knot the score at 20-20. Graboski then added the game-winning extra point for the Pointers to give UWSP their sixth win of the 2008 season by three points or less, 21-20.

For the Pointers, Jenkins finished with 12 catches for 156 yards and three scores. Beckwith finished 246 yards through the air completing 19 of his 30 pass attempts and all three touchdowns to Jenkins. Mike Ferron (Racine) had 23 carries for 66 yards with a long of 14.

For Eau Claire, Sartorelli finished the day with 31 carries for 155 yards and two touchdowns rushing. He also had four receptions for 67 yards and one score.

UW-Stevens Point (8-1, 5-1 WIAC) holds their lead over UW-Whitewater for first place in the WIAC standings as the Pointers hold the tiebreaker against the Warhawks for the league title. The Pointers host UW-La Crosse on Nov. 15 in their final regular-season game 1 p.m. at Community Stadium. UW-Eau Claire (5-4, 3-3 WIAC), losers of two straight, will play UW-Stout in Menomonie next weekend in their season finale.

Hello 14th WIAC Title

STEVENS POINT - The UW-Stevens Point football team captured a share of its 14th Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference title and clinched a playoff berth as they defeated the Eagles of UW-La Crosse 21-7 at Community Stadium Saturday afternoon.

The Pointers held the Eagles offense to just 120 yards and used three touchdown receptions by Brad Kalsow (Huntley, Ill.) to seal up their first conference title since 2001.

On a cold and blustery afternoon at Goerke Park, the Pointers got on the board first late in the first quarter when Jared Beckwith (Baraboo) hit Kalsow for a 12-yard touchdown pass to give the Pointers a 7-0 advantage.

But the Eagles tied things up in the second quarter when Gus Almonroeder caught an 8-yard touchdown pass from Nick Anker to make it 7-7.

On the ensuing Pointer possession, Beckwith took the Pointers offense 59 yards in 44 seconds when he threw his second touchdown pass to Kalsow for 19 yards to give the Pointers a 14-7 lead at the half.

The second half was all about the Pointers defense, as they forced three turnovers and did not allow a point.

The Eagles opening possession in the second half ended quickly as Bryan Blum (Baraboo) picked off Anker to keep the momentum with the Pointers.

After a couple of punts by each team, the Pointers extended their lead when Beckwith threw his third touchdown pass to Kalsow on a 9-yard pitch and catch to extend the Pointers lead to 21-7.

Both teams went scoreless in the fourth quarter, as the Pointers used an interception by Luke Frisch (Nekoosa), a fumble recovery by John Jones (Oregon), and a turnover on downs to keep La Crosse at bay.

The Pointers will return to action in the first round of the NCAA Division III Playoffs at time and location that is yet to-be-determined.
