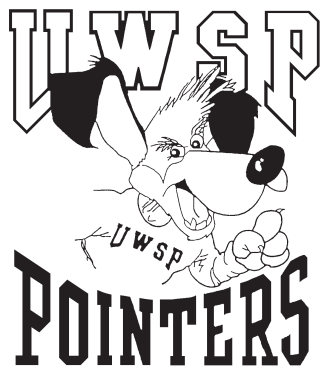

Head Coach Shirley Egner: Coach Egner has compiled a 349-165 overall record in her 20 seasons at the helm of the Pointers, ranking second on the all-time WIAC wins list. The Pointers have won at least 18 games each of the past eight seasons and own a league-best .813 winning percentage during that time. Egner's all-time coaching record, including high school, is 490-215.

The Series: The Pointers lead the all-time series with the Falcons 44-22. The Pointers have won three-straight against the Falcons, who's last win against UW-Stevens Point came in the quarterfinal round of the WIAC tournament Feb. 19, 2007. With that victory back in 2007, the Falcons became the first team ever to beat the Pointers twice on their home court and were just the fourth team all-time to defeat the Pointers three times overall in a season.

The Streak: The Pointers enter Wednesday's game on a 13-game winning streak, dating back to a Dec. 3 win over North Central. The Pointers last loss came at the hands of Wednesday's opponent, UW-Eau Claire, in the championship game of the UW-Eau Claire Thanksgiving Showcase. The 13 straight wins ties a school record for consecutive wins, last accomplished during the 1986-87 season.

Recipe For Success: The Pointers rank second in the nation in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 48.2 points per game. Couple that with the nation's 75th ranked offense that scores 70.6 points per game and you have a recipe for the nation's fifth-best scoring margin, as the Pointers outscore their opponents by an average of 22.4 points per game.

The Pointers also rank tied for fourth in all of Division III in win-loss percentage, boasting a .944 winning percentage. Only three teams remain undefeated; Amherst, George Fox and Ill. Wesleyan.

Is that goal regulation size or what?: Sophomore Britta Petersen ranks 24th in the nation in field-goal percentage, shooting an impressive 55.0 percent from the floor. Petersen, who averages 13.2 points per game, good for seventh best in the WIAC.

Get that outta here: Petersen is turning away shots at an impressive season. She ranks second in the conference in blocks per game, swatting away 1.61 shots per game. Her 29 blocks this season ranks second only to Whitewater's Tiffany Morton who has 41 blocks, a 2.28 per game average.
