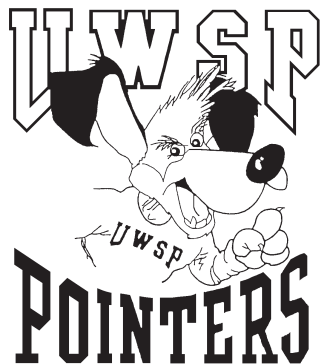

Head Coach Shirley Egner: Coach Egner has compiled a 342-165 overall record in her 20 seasons at the helm of the Pointers, ranking second on the all-time WIAC wins list. The Pointers have won at least 18 games each of the past eight seasons and own a league-best .813 winning percentage during that time. Egner's all-time coaching record, including high school, is 483-215.

Hot Start: Boasting a 10-1 record to start the week, the Pointers are off to another hot start. This is the second straight season the Pointers have started at least 10-1. Last season UWSP started 15-1 before suffering back-to-back losses to fall to 15-3.

The Series: The Pointers are a combined 97-36 against this week's opponents. The Pointers hold the edge in all three series, boasting an 11-2 advantage over Lawrence, a 43-22 edge over River Falls and a 43-12 edge over Platteville.

The Vikings: The Vikings are led by senior forward Erin Henzi, who ran her streak of scoring in double figures to four games over the break, scoring 13 and 27 points in two games in Orlando, Fla. On the season, Henzi is averaging 16.1 points per game and 6.1 rebounds, both team highs.

The Falcons: The Falcons are led by freshman forward Tiffany Gregorich, who has appeared in all 12 games this season for UW-River Falls. Coming off the bench in those 12 games, Gregorich is averaging 12.8 points per game and averaging 19 minutes. Another freshman, Alise Holst, is the team's leading rebounder, pulling down 8.5 boards per game and adding 10.8 points per game.

The Pioneers: The Pioneers have three scorers averaging in double figures, as senior Lisa Grantman and juniors Charity Stotmeister and Stacia Nemitz are averaging 12.6, 11.4 and 10.8 points respectively. Nemitz is the team's leading rebounder, pulling down 5.4 boards per game, but Grantman isn't far behind, grabbing 5.2 per contest.

Last Time Out: The Pointers held UW-Oshkosh to an all-time low of 31 points on their way to a 40 point route of the Titans in Oshkosh. Janelle Van Gomple led the way, scoring a team-high 19 points in the victory.

Rank'em: The Pointers rank first in several categories in the WIAC. The Pointers are first in scoring defense, scoring margin, field goal percentage, 3-pt field goal percentage defense, assists, turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. All that combines to a tie for first place atop the WIAC standings for the Pointers. The Pointers and UW-Eau Claire sit atop the league, each boasting 3-0 league records.
