## WIAC Tournament Recap

The Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) Championships were held in Madison, WI, at Nielsen Tennis Stadium, on October 20<sup>th</sup> and October 21<sup>st</sup>. This was the final event of the fall 2007 season. The UWSP tennis team had three singles players place third and one doubles team place third.

No. 1 singles player Rachel Benn finished in third place by beating Allie Hinman from UW-Stout, 7-6, 4-6, 6-4. Also placing third was No. 4 singles player Emily Bouché. Completing her senior season, Emily defeated Sarah Schoenwaelder of UW-La Crosse, 6-1, 4-6, 6-3. At No. 6 singles, Kaylei Sorensen was the last singles player to finish in third place. Kaylei beat Alison Broerman of UW-Oshkosh, 2-6, 7-5, 7-6 (3).

The No. 3 doubles team of Emily Bouché and Emily Oxtan defeated Cassie Wood and Stacie Kozel of UW-River Falls 8-1 to capture the third place finish.

Kaitlyn King placed fifth at both No. 5 singles and No. 2 doubles, along with partner Mashell VerBockel. Mashell VerBockel was also named to the all-sportsmanship team.

As a team, UWSP played extremely well and pulled out close matches against tough opponents. The team finished the season with an overall record of 7 wins and 5 losses. The WIAC tournament showed that UWSP tennis can compete and win. The future of UWSP Tennis looks bright!
