## WIAC Conference Tournament Recap

This past weekend (Oct. 25<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>) the Pointer Women's Tennis Team competed in the WIAC Conference Tournament. Entering the weekend the goal was to place in the top four. Finishing in the top four qualifies the team to play in the WIAC Spring Tournament. The winner of the spring tournament gets the automatic qualifier to the NCAA Tournament.

The Pointer Tennis Team put up a valiant fight, but fell four points short of their goal, finishing in fifth place. However, it was the best Pointer finish since 1999. UW-Whitewater was the overall conference winner, with UW-La Crosse, UW-Eau Claire and UW-Oshkosh advancing to the spring tournament.

Top finishers for UWSP included Chelsea Allbaugh, playing No. 2 singles, Kaylei Sorensen playing No. 4 singles, and the No. 1 doubles tandem of Rachel Benn and Allbaugh. Chelsea finished in second place, losing the championship match to UW-Whitewater's Ingrid Stensvaag (6-2, 6-2). To get to the championship match Chelsea defeated UW-Stout's Mandy O'Keefe (6-4, 6-4), then upset the No. 2 seeded player from UW-La Crosse, Carlie Bohrman (1-6, 6-1, 7-5).

At No. 4 singles, Kaylei Sorensen won her opening round match by defeating Lindsay Gillman from UW-River Falls (6-2, 6-1). The win earned the senior a fourth place finish in her final collegiate match.

The No. 1 doubles team of Rachel Benn and Chelsea Allbaugh saved their best doubles play for the weekend tournament. In the opening round match Benn/Allbaugh defeated the third seeded team from UW-Oshkosh, Jenna Abbott/Emily Bostwick, 8-6. In the second round the UWSP duo defeated the second seeded team from UW-La Crosse, Sarah Schoenwaelder/Carlie Bohrman, 8-6. In the championship match, the team from UW-Whitewater, Kalla Schaefer and Amy Siemon, was too tough and ended the Pointer run, 8-1. Great job Chelsea and Rachel!
